CCIA Offers Recommendations on GDPR enforcement

Brussels -- The Computer & Communications Industry Association today filed comments on the enforcement of the EU's General Data Protection Regulation ('GDPR') in response to a consultation from the European Commission.

Two years after the implementation of GDPR, CCIA has observed inadequate funding for European privacy watchdogs to conduct their oversight. This partly translates into a lack of instruments for companies to transfer data outside Europe. CCIA also raises concerns about unharmonised enforcement across the continent which runs counter to the goal of the GDPR and the ambition of creating one EU Single Market.

CCIA urges Member States to appropriately fund their supervisory authorities and for DPAs to adhere to the GDPR and the EU Single Market.

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#GDPR is turning two! Here's our top recommendations:

- (1) Data Protection Authorities need more resources, eg to develop additional intl data transfer tools
- (2) DPAs should more consistently apply GDPR across the EU Single Market
