



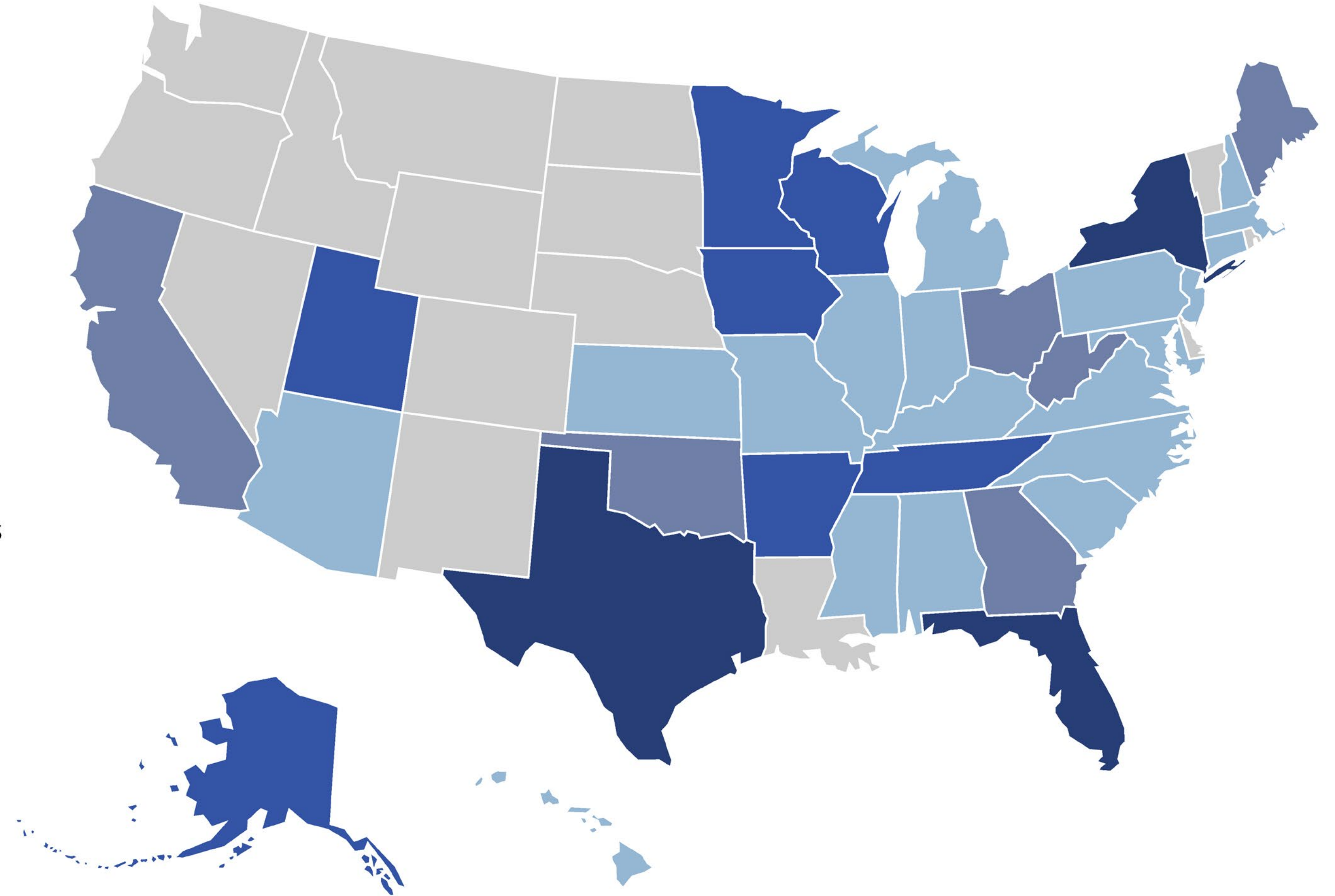
State Content Moderation Landscape

State legislatures are considering or enacting restrictions on private companies' ability to exercise their First Amendment right to determine what material is appropriate for their communities. These bills not only raise constitutional issues, but also stand to increase digital services' legal risks while they work to reduce dangerous online content like scams, fraud and propaganda. States have considered various measures involving content moderation over the past year.

Most state legislatures have adjourned until 2023. This map represents bills from the 2022 legislative session in addition to carryover or enacted bills from 2021.
